Dear Parent(s),

Post-season play is a very rewarding experience, but also a very demanding one. It requires commitment from both the player and her family. Because of the intense commitment and schedule your player's softball skills will improve significantly throughout the All-Star experience. We will have skilled coaches who will be positive and encouraging in how they interact with you and your daughter. They will also do their best to improve your child's skills in the best position for their ability. It's also important to note that your daughter may learn a new position or be asked to play or bat in a position they are not used to. We commit to doing our best to prepare them through practice and encouragement.

In order to plan ahead & for your player to be considered for All Stars, the following must be completed by the parent(s) for each player. This consideration DOES NOT mean your daughter will be selected to play All Stars. It is simply a form to provide the parents notification of the level of commitment & any potential scheduling conflicts that will be considered when selecting players.

Be sure to read each line, check each box & initial on Parent Initial line – Thank You!
(Parent Initial) Practice Commitment: 2 to 3 practices per week starting mid May through the final tournament in late June with the possibility of tournaments through end of July. Practices last approximately 2 hours. (Note: There may be additional practices for teams that qualify for Regional & State Championships).
(Parent Initial) Team Commitment : 3 to 5 tournaments June - July (See page 2 - Note: there may be additional tournaments for teams that qualify for Regional & State Championships). CGS attempts to keep the teams at an appropriate size for tournaments, but players and families need to be aware that this is tournament play. In All Stars, CGS does not guarantee equal playing time since we play to win. Not all the girls' bat and not all have to play an inning in most tournaments. However, all girls are expected to attend practice/tournaments and be part of the team.
(Parent Initial) Tournament Commitment: All Star Tournaments have been selected (see page 2). Approximately a week before each Tournament, Carmichael Girls All Star Teams are assigned a game schedule by the host league. Games can begin as early as Thursday afternoon and continue into Sunday. There can be as many as 3 to 4 games per day.
(Parent Initial) Financial Commitment: The cost will be \$250 per player for the tournament season. This fee covers the cost of the tournaments and uniforms.
(Parent Initial) Fireworks Booth: Teams will be required to volunteer for the Fireworks Booth June 28th thru July 4th. (4 hrs. per family per player)
